IN LOVING MEMORY

Our sanctuary candle burns this month in memory of the **Pierre-Louis** family, given by **Laetitia Pierre-Louis**.



Mom and the rest of my family will be departing for home on this Wednesday afternoon. Over the weekend, all of my siblings showed up and stayed at the rectory. Although there were not enough beds - couches and cots were utilized, there were enough rooms for everyone. Mom did love the attention received from her children, grand children and especially the loving respect from the parishioners. At the Sunday banquet, she took out her dentures and placed them on the table so she could eat comfortably. She hates wearing dentures and thus never gets used to them. Later, when walking outside to catch some fresh air I saw my oldest sister organizing a group of men going through the trash bags one by one. About 20 bags. It was not a very pretty sight. Men with gloves dumping and shifting carefully the contents to find mom's dentures. After an hour, nothing came up. But there were two more trash bags taken home early by a parishioner to help alleviate the issue of the church not having yet a dumpster. Yup, the dentures were in one of those two bags and they were promptly returned to the rightful mouth!

Yesterday, mom wanted to go to the fish market. Since the onset of the pandemic, she had not gone anywhere much to public places. So I took her to C-Mart. As soon as she was wheeled to the fish section, she stood up and immediately caressed the fish. Growing up by the ocean in a fishing village, the scent and the skin of the fish perhaps is mom's subconsciously desiring to recall the childhood days among her family and friends - memories of sweetness and much laughters mixed in with deep political turbulence. My sister had to run back into the market twice, once to get her some filets of fish and again to get her a papaya.

This afternoon may be the last time that I see her toothless smile!

With a heart full of gratitude, I thank the many hands and many thousand drops of sweat of those who set up, cooked, sang, cleaned up, danced, served and prayed so that the Mass and the reception went on so beautifully. The church and the gym were packed with happy faces. Bishop Mark at the beginning of Mass, when gazing at the gathering congregation, exclaimed only one single word: "Wow!" For it is wonderful to see the church filled with people. It is wonderful to see the church coming alive. Indeed, it is fantastically wonderful to see St. Clement's Church is once again bursting with joy, laughter and the Spirit of God. We are very blessed indeed.

The dispensation from the Sunday Mass Obligation is lifted on this weekend. So please inform this change to your fellow Catholic neighbors. Tell them that it is good to gather as a people of God. Tell them that it is the best feeling to be able to sing of God's greatness and God's holy presence to and with one another. Tell them that St. Clement's is alive. Tell them that St. Clement's needs them. And tell them that St. Clement's misses them.

I am completely exhausted. My voice is coming back slowly. This aged body can not handle late nights anymore. Thus I am making a vow to myself to get back to healthy eating and physical exercise and proper rest. Next week. My spirit needs a healthy body. My spirit needs a healthy mind. My spirit is desperately in need of a healthy soul. So help me God!
