

## FROM FATHER PHONG

Greg William took me out for golf on Monday morning, just nine holes, and my first ever since my arrival to Massachusetts two years ago. No stretching. No hitting practice balls at the range. No warm up. Just a few swings in the air. Then to the tee box. A few wiggles of the driver. Bam. The ball took off no higher than ten feet in the air. Damage on the first hole? A nice triple bogey. Yes, as the round progressed I did much better. Three pars for nine holes ain't a bad feat.

Then the news broke out that the killing of Daunte Wright was due to an officer mistakenly drawing out a gun instead of a taser. Then the rain came down. I got a little wet while crossing over to the church to see the letters above the interior entrance being repainted. The two older gentlemen did an excellent job. The words "I am the resurrection and the life. Come to me all you who are weary and burdened and I will give you rest" are now gleaming with a golden coat. I said a quick prayer for Daunte Wright that he too shall be wrapped with a golden coat of everlasting peace. But how the heck can an experienced officer fail to tell the difference between holding a taser and a gun? I then hurried back to the rectory. Showered. Dressed up in my cleric. I needed to look official for the meeting, even on Zoom, with the archdiocesan Director of Finance. I had to make a report about the "potential" repair-replace-upgrade of our facilities here at St. Clement's. They really worry about the asbestos wrapped around the pipes down in the rectory's basement. Realizing that my mind is weary and heart heavily burdened, I jumped into the Wrangler and drove north east to Gloucester. And how the heck Gloucester pronounced as "glosster" is beyond my comprehension. Is it just like a gun mistakenly used for a taser?

I sat at a bench perched artistically yet rather lonely on a huge boulder and beheld the majestic scene with the water, the salty air, the ducks below and the birds above. The wind however was a bit strong. With just a sweater it didn't take long for me to surrender and return the bench back to its solitude. I got back on the windy road and just drove. I passed a bunch of small towns and finally headed south on 128. Back to home. Back to the busy traffic with fast cars and anxious drivers presumably rushing to get back to home. Home, when I was a child growing up amidst bomb explosions and bullet rains, was where my parents and brothers and sisters and the dining table which was used as a bed at night for me and one of my younger brothers. Home now, I am told, is where the heart is. But who the heck can claim to know with certainty of the heart's whereabouts? For the heart's whereabouts, I think, is as predictable as the weather, as the wind, as the cloud, or as the flight of my golf ball...

And I have to admit that sometimes I do question not only the existence but the claims of and about God. I admit that lots of time I almost lost my hope to despair and faith to absurdities. Quite often I allowed negativities to tear apart my trust in the hierarchical Church. And indeed, occasionally I had been tempted to walk over to the "Dark Side." Almost but not yet. Tempted but not succumbed. I still am stumbling along in faith, with my fists clenching onto whatever hope left in my heart and my soul longing for meaningfulness, for world peace, for humanity living in harmony, for God.

I know. I know. Perhaps on Mondays I should stay in bed. Perhaps if I were to get out of bed I should steer clear of the golf course. Perhaps if I were to play golf I should refrain afterward from watching television. A triple bogey on the first hole and the daily news are a deadly combination.

Pray for Daunte Wright. Pray for officer Kim Potter. Pray for Minneapolis. Pray for America. Pray for this humanity and this world. By now, you and I should have felt a little bit of God's anguish and tasted a drop or two of God's salty tears.
